To All Members of Your Camping Club:

We would like to invite you to our park for the winter. We are running a special for "Snowbirds" that do not want to drive all the way to Florida with the gas prices skyrocketing like they are.

If you come for November 2007 thru February 2008 we are offering the total price of \$1320.00 if it is paid by November 1, 2007. If you are not sure you want to stay for four months, we offer a second choice of \$385.00 for the first month and the balance of \$1050.00 due December 1, 2007 for the last three months. All lots have 30/50 amp electric, water, sewer and cable TV included. We have a laundry/game room in the park, a pool and club house for dinners and activities.

We are a laid back park in the historical town of Milledgeville Georgia We are geographically located in the center of Georgia which makes it convenient to travel throughout the state for day trips.

DRIVING NORTH

We are two hours from Atlanta which has the largest Aquarium, the Atlanta Zoo, the Coca Cola Museum, Stone Mountain and Six Flags. Four hours north you get to Historic mountain area of Dahlonega where the first gold strike was made in America. Take a tour of a gold mine and when you are done you can pan for gold. Helen is a short distance from there and is a Bavarian style town.

DRIVING SOUTH

Going south we are only three hours from Valdosta and Wild Adventure theme park. About an hour and a half south you will be in Cordele which is the home town for the SAM Shortline Railway. You can make it a one or two day train ride going thru Plains Georgia and ending in Americus before returning to Cordele. You may get off in any town along the way and spend the night and pick up the train again the next day. Perry is located an hour away and is the home of the state fairgrounds, which has activities going all the time.

DRIVING EAST

Going east by way of US 16 we are two hours from Savannah, the oldest town in Georgia, where you can take an informative trolley ride thru town, stop and shop or take a walking tour of the Ghost areas in town. Don't forget to visit the Ocean while there from Tybee Island.

DRIVING WEST

Going west you are only 45 minutes from Macon another historic town with a trolley tour of homes and churches. Macon is home of the Music hall of fame and great shopping. You are only 3 hours from the Callaway Gardens in Columbus. Don't forget the "Whistle Stop Café" (Fried Green Tomato movie) is located in Julliette GA only 45 minutes away--still serving Fried Green Tomatoes.

As you can see we are only a short distance from many of the major attractions in Georgia, however, some of the best is right here locally in our town of Milledgeville. We are the capital of antebellum homes and great architecture. You may take a 2 hours trolley ride thru our town and learn the history of the civil war in this area. You can tour the governors' mansion, 1806-1863 capital building that has been made into a military school and houses the historical museum or take your time going through some of the old homes. We also have Lake Sinclair in our county for fishing and boating.
